

Rhode Island School of Design Smoke- Free Campus Policy

For reasons of public health and in compliance with RI law, smoking is prohibited in any building at Rhode Island School of Design. This prohibition extends to all RISD buildings, including but not limited to classrooms, studios, hallways, residential facilities and buildings, restrooms, the library, the museum, and dining facilities. Smoking is also prohibited within RISD owned or leased vehicles.

All smoking is limited to the outside away from exits and entranceways to ensure the prevention of smoke migration into any RISD building.

Any questions you may have regarding this policy should be directed to the Associate Vice President for Human Resources, the Associate Provost, Student Affairs, or the Director of Environmental Health and Safety. The success of this policy depends upon the cooperation of everyone. All faculty, staff and students share the responsibility for following the policy. Any problems should be referred to the appropriate department head or supervisor.
